**Steps**

- Mobilize **30 aspiring learners or more** in order to earn **US\$120 or more** per month for the **three months (12 weeks)** learning cycle.
- Your mobilized learners do not need any qualifications apart from having **(1) a Society Profiting Business Product or Service that will drive social change in society, (2) mobile phones/number for enabling real-time communication, (3) mentor, (4) e-mail address (5) a thorough understanding of either English or Swahili, both spoken & written with Computer skills.**
- Use the **SWEET Africa Experts idea guide, the SDGs profile and SWEET Africa photo idea gallery-all on this website** to help your learners identify a developmental idea that will largely benefit society.
- Support your selected learners to complete the **first stage online-application** (*Offline template available for guidance on the website*).
- Ensure that each aspiring learner has a **mentor and/exam supervisor** (*Consult the website/brochure about the purpose of each*).

- Support your first stage- SWEET Africa qualified learners to complete the **second stage/application/registration** process with the outcome notification expected within 3-5 days.
- Facilitate your second stage- SWEET Africa qualified **30 learners or more** with learning aid support for 12 weeks, with **SWEET Africa financially committed to reimbursing your facilitation** on monthly basis (***US\$120/month or more-to be detailed in a formal contract once recruited***).
- One of the basic requirement for your recruitment as a local facilitator is that **all your selected 30 learners or more must have fulfilled all required application/registration formalities of SWEET Africa.**

**Your Target Population**

- African/none African, old/young, family/couples, as well as groups/agencies/institutions, that want to gain valuable tools to make an impact on lives of the poor, marginalized and vulnerable Africans.

**Course Deliverables for your learners**

- 12 week rigorous electronic learning, Two Assignments submission Electronically, Four Self- administered Assignments, One-Midterm/Final Written Exam, Certificate of completion (Completers)& attainment (Exam Attainers).

### Resource Deliverables for your learners

### Registration and Optional Fees for your learners

- Non-Refundable Application Processing Fee(**US\$30**), Optional Fees (**US\$10**) for both Midterm /Final Written Exams, and Business Plan Polishing (**US\$10**), Optional Fees are subject to a **10% discount for all individual students (18+years), women applicants, and applicants above 60 years**, Group/Family applications accepted, **5% -10%** discounts applies if five or more people enroll as group learners. **Discounts for large groups are available when supported by a local facilitator.** Quotations provided following application review. Only one (1) discount per person per group per enrolment can be claimed at any one time.

### Admission process for your learners

- All qualified learners who present all required documentation at the second application stage, including evidence of payment for the registration and where applicable, evidence of payment for the

optional learning assessment, receive enrollment letters plus user names (the emails they provided when registering) together with login in passwords to download their study materials. **This means the learners you will facilitate do not need to be full-time on the INTERNET to access study materials.** Assignments submission can be either via e-mail or through the online assignment submission system.

### Career Prospects for your learners

- **The start-up of a new business:** launch a new social enterprise business venture that addresses a pressing social need.
- **The opening of a “social franchise”:** replicate successful international business models in your native country/community.
